
CORELDRAW.... basic rendering

Fills and Outlines

CorelDRAW allows you to apply different Fills and Outlines to your drawings.

A Fill will affect the area inside the shape, an outline just changes the properties of the line around your shape.

Before you can apply a Fill to a shape, you must be sure that the shape is closed i.e. all the edges meet without



Copy and paste the truck that you made earlier into a new document.

Do this by drawing a square around the whole truck with the select tool. Then go to Edit > Copy

Go to File > New to open a new document and then Edit > Paste to paste your drawing.

Select one of the shapes in your truck using the select tool.

Open the Object Properties Docker and click on the Fill tab at the top (it looks like a paint bucket)

Experiment with different colours using the palette and try different effects using the buttons above the palette

Next click on the Outline tab (it looks like a fountain pen)

Quick Colouring

You can also use the palette at the far right of the screen to colour objects quickly. Use the LEFT mouse button to select a Fill colour and the RIGHT mouse button to select an outline colour.
